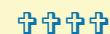

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today is the Second Sunday of Easter which is also called Divine Mercy Sunday. On April 30, 2000, Pope St. John Paul II canonized St. Faustina who received from Jesus the revelation of the Divine Mercy. On this special occasion, the Pope also extended this Feast to the entire Church on the Sunday after Easter.

Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us that God the Father of mercy, whose mercy was manifested in the sacrificial death on the cross of His Son, Jesus Christ, for the redemption our sins. The mercy of the Father is also manifested in the Holy Spirit whose mission is to sanctify us and to bring us back to God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As in today's Gospel Jesus said: "Receive the Holy Spirit, whose sins you forgive are forgiven them". For this reason, the Holy Spirit is constantly working in and through the priests and the Sacraments of the Church for the sanctification of the faithful until the end of time.

St. Thomas was invited to: "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe". We too are invited to come and touch Jesus' wounds as the testimony of His Divine Mercy. It is because of God's infinite mercy that our sins are forgiven, the sins that nailed Jesus to the cross and pierced open His side. Let us come to worship our merciful God who is present in the Eucharist. Let us come to touch the wounded Jesus in the sacrifice of the Mass and do not be unbelieving, but believe.

May the Mercy of God melt our harden hearts so that we might be able to cry out from our hearts "my Lord and my God, I believe".
