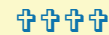

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we approach Holy Week, the celebration of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection, we must be reminded of what kind of God we are worshiping and how merciful He is toward sinners.

Today's Gospel tells us that the adulterous woman was condemned and brought to Jesus by the people and how sad it was for Jesus to tell them: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her". What the people did not know was that when they condemned the adulterous woman, they ironically imposed condemnation upon themselves. Hopefully, we all should learn from the lesson of the Gospel today since Jesus said: "Do not judge and you will not be judged; and do not condemn and you will not be condemned..." (Luke 6:37).

As sinners we do not have any right to condemn other sinners; only God has the right to condemn or pass judgement. On the other hand, God does give us the privilege to forgive others. How often do we exercise this God-given privilege? Whenever we exercise forgiveness, we are indeed forgiving ourselves: "Forgive, and you will be forgiven" (Luke 6:37). In the presence of God, we all want to be shown mercy and forgiveness when we sin. During this Lenten Season, let us open our hearts toward those who have sinned against us, especially those who are so close to us, so that the stream of mercy pours out upon them.

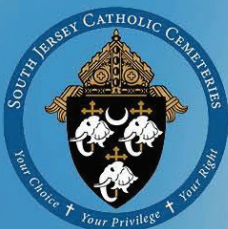
