Therefore, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on Sunday, replacing the liturgical celebration and readings of the Seventh Sunday of Easter; this year May 29, 2022.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



May is the Month that the Church encourages the faithful to have a special devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary by praying the Holy Rosary. On May 13, it will mark the 105th Anniversary of the apparition of the Virgin Mary in Fatima, Portugal. This miraculous event happened not many centuries ago but in 1917.

The Blessed Virgin Mary had appeared several times to the three young children: Francisco Marto, Jacinta Marto, and Lucia dos Santos. She repeatedly told them to pray the Rosary for the conversion of sinners and world leaders. She also asked them to spread this devotional message to others and indeed to the whole world. In confirming the authentic divine message from the Blessed Virgin Mary to the world, God performed a powerful and remarkable miracle in front of the eyes of thousands of people, that is, the sun was moving and jumping up and down in the sky. The eye witnesses were so terrified, they thought that was going to be the end of the world. This powerful miracle was documented with photographs and thousands of eye witnesses; therefore it did not take the Church too long to declare its authenticity for the faithful to believe.

The Fatima Marian Apparition has revealed to us the power of praying the Holy Rosary. As Mary said to the three children, by praying the Holy Rosary, it could change the hearts of sinners and world leaders so that sinners might return to God and “World War” could be avoided. Mary, knows the “heart” of God, she knows what God wants, she knows what prayers would be so powerful in the presence of God, and that is, the prayer of the Holy Rosary. This Prayer can change the “evil of the heart”, it illuminates the “darkness of the conscience”, whether it exists in the family, Church, society or in the world. Let us take time to pray the Holy Rosary during this special month, praying for peace in the world and the conversion of sinners. -Fr. Joe Pham

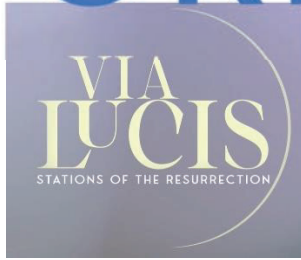

From The Sacred Penitentiary: Indulgence for the Centenary

To increase the holiness of the faithful and for the salvation of souls, by virtue of the faculty granted to it in a special way by the Most Reverend Father in Christ and Our Master, the Lord Francis, by Divine Providence, Pope, having taken note of the requests made by Mary Murphy, President of the Association called the Legion of Mary, on the occasion of its one hundredth anniversary, the Apostolic Penitentiary graciously concedes from the heavenly treasures of the Church a plenary indulgence properly fulfilled under the usual conditions (sacramental Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the intention of the Holy Pontiff) to the members of the association and to other members of the faithful who are truly penitent, to be gained from 7 September 2021 until 7 September 2022, which can be applied for the souls of the faithful detained in Purgatory by way of suffrage, if they visit any church of the said Association or wherever on pilgrimage and are present devoutly at the joyful celebrations, or at least recite the Lord's Prayer and the Creed devoutly, with added pious appeals to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The aged, the sick, and all who cannot leave home for a grave reason, can gain equally the Plenary Indulgence, having evinced a detestation of sin and a purpose of amendment, where first permitted, under the three usual conditions, if they join themselves spiritually to the joyful celebrations, offering the prayers, sorrows or misfortunes of their own lives to the mercy of God.

In order to facilitate out of pastoral charity such visits for the reception of the divine forgiveness through the keys of the Church, this Penitentiary especially requests priests who have the faculties to hear the confessions of the said people, to make themselves available with prompt and generous heart for the celebration of Confession.

This letter is only valid for this purpose. All other things to the contrary notwithstanding.

Given at Rome, from the seat of the Apostolic Penitentiary, on 7 of September, in the Year of Our Lord's Incarnation 2021.
