Therefore, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on Sunday, replacing the liturgical celebration and readings of the Seventh Sunday of Easter; this year May 29, 2022.

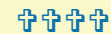

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus gave us his heartfelt advice: "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." Jesus spoke these words from the depth of his heart. He did not order us to do something if he himself didn't do it first.

There are undeniable facts that we are all sinners, we all make mistakes, we all want to be forgiven, and ultimately we all want to be loved by God no matter how sinful we are. Jesus knows who we are: we are sinful beings, who sin, make mistakes, and fail everyday; however he still loves each one of us unconditionally and forgives us unreservedly. Now the only thing he asks of us in return is to "love one another". However, in order to do this, we first need to be reminded of our own sinfulness, our own unworthiness, and our own brokenness, since it is easier for a drug addict to understand and sympathize for another drug addict than a clean person or it is easier for an adulterer to show mercy, and forgiveness for another adulterer than an ever faithful one.

Indeed, God's love cannot enter one's selfish heart who only wants to be forgiven and to be loved by God, but does not want to forgive or to love others. This commandment of "love one another" means opening one's heart to make it possible for forgiveness, for reconciliation, for healing, and for conversion. When keeping this commandment, we do not do any favor for the ones who receive our love; but rather we do a favor for ourselves as Jesus said: "forgive, and you will be forgiven, give and it will be given to you." (Mark 4:24).

Therefore; let us forgive ourselves by forgiving one another, let us love ourselves by loving one another so that "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another". *Fr. Joe Pham*


