The Bishops of the Ecclesiastical Province of Newark decided to permanently transfer the observance of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus from Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter to the following Sunday. Therefore, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus will be celebrated in all the Latin-rite dioceses of New Jersey on Sunday, replacing the liturgical celebration readings of the Seventh Sunday of Easter; this year May 29, 2022.
