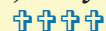

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the Second Reading today, St. Paul reminds us of living our lives “free” from our sinful nature which was put to death on the cross by our Lord Jesus Christ: “For freedom Christ set us free, so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery.”

Our human nature, damaged by original sin, always inclines to oppose against the “spirit” of doing good and avoiding evil. However, Our Lord Jesus nailed our sinful nature on the cross and made it anew after his resurrection. He freed us from eternal damnation which was brought upon our nature by sin. Through Baptism, which symbolically signifies our “passover” from death to life in Christ, we are “reborn” and thus should not live under the slavery of sin again; but rather as St. Paul said: “For you were called for freedom, brothers and sisters. But do not use this freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, rather, serve one another through love.”

St. Paul used the word “flesh” to signify the unredeemed human sinful nature and the word “spirit” to signify the new born human nature through the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. As a new born in Christ, we should live in the spirit of Christ which is love. Whoever lives in love is free from the slavery of sin and thus free from condemnation. In the Gospel today, Jesus rebuked James and John because their hearts and minds were under the slavery of sin when they were quick to condemn: “Lord do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them? Jesus turned and rebuked them”. As they were journeying with Jesus and in the company of Jesus, they should act on the “spirit” of Jesus, the spirit of love and forgiveness, rather than act on the “flesh”, the sinful nature.

Let us take off our sinful nature and nail it to the cross with Jesus and put on ourselves a new “redeemed nature”, the spirit of Christ, which is love, patience, temperance, perseverance, and forgiveness. Let us fix our eyes upon Jesus and keep journeying with him for: “No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God.” *-Fr. Joe Pham*
