EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2020, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of "renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." The theme of the Revival is: "My Flesh for the Life of the World" This three- year- effort will have three phases: (1) Diocesan; (2) Parish; and (3) National.

Our Diocese will solemnly open with a candlelight Corpus Christi Procession on the Boardwalk in Atlantic City on <u>Saturday, June 18th</u>. The Procession will begin at 8:00 PM at Tennessee Avenue and the Boardwalk and process three-quarters of a mile to Kennedy Plaza. The event will end at approximately 9:15 PM.
