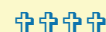

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

After six years of being the pastor of Infant Jesus Parish, I couldn't be more grateful to God for His wisdom and guidance and, to each one of you, for your prayerful and loving support. One thing that touches me the most about this parish is the spirit of loving service.



Our parish has so many pastoral ministries, so many people actively getting involved in various aspects of the parish life. Good willed and good hearted people have offered their time, treasure, and talents for the sake of the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church. Jesus truly needs each one of us as His helping hand to build up His Kingdom on earth, the Kingdom in which every action, motivation, and intention must be inspired and driven by the love of God and His people.

The Gospel of this weekend tells us about two aspects of living which represented by the two characters: Martha and Mary. Martha was so caught up with the busy "doing" and forgot about the "being". The reason why Martha complained to Jesus about her sister not helping her because she found it was a burden in doing the serving. For Martha the "doing" is prior to the "being". However, Mary chose the "being" part by being in the presence of Jesus, being inspired by His words, and being embraced by his love prior to the "doing".

Like Martha, we often find our lives caught up with busy "doing" and neglect another aspect of life that is "being". We are "being" for the sake of doing and not "doing" for the sake of being. As Jesus said: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

The moral meaning is that, before making any decision or doing anything, we should put ourselves first in the presence of God through prayers so that our decisions or our work would be inspired by Jesus' words and motivated by His love. In this way our daily labors would not become a burden; but rather they would become a joy and a fulfillment of "human being" and not "human doing".

**Mission Co-Op for Lumen Christi Institute  
Arusha, Tanzania**

**Weekend of July 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022**

Cordial greetings Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Each year the diocese of Camden designates a specific weekend to draw attention to the importance of missionary activity in spreading the gospel throughout the world and supporting those called to provide for the spiritual and material needs of Jesus' flock. I am grateful to the Diocese of Camden and to the pastor Reverend Joseph Pham, for granting me the opportunity this weekend to speak about our mission in Africa.

The purpose of this Mission Co-Op appeal is to seek your help and support specifically for three things: 1. For the feeding and the education of the orphan children who are boarded in our school. 2. To provide medicine and health care to many young children and expectant mothers. 3. For expanded lecture halls and operating expenses for our rapidly growing seminary at Lumen Christi Institute, Arusha Catholic Diocese in Tanzania.

Through our education ministry, we provide shelter and quality education for many orphan children who otherwise would not have the opportunity for an education. Past two years due to COVID19, many families lost their loved ones, and many parents lost their jobs and so are unable to feed the children. We had to take a loan out at 15% interest to feed the children. Through our health ministry, we are providing free medicine and health care to many young children, expectant mothers, and elderly. Without the help and support from others, we are unable to provide needed medicine and to run the dispensary.

Since our religious congregation is getting numerous vocations (the last academic year 2021- 2022 – 65 seminarians were enrolled and the next year 2022-2023 that number will increase to 70), we are now forced to expand immediately the lecture halls in the seminary as the existing ones are too small as they accommodate only 30 students. While the increasing number of seminarians every year has truly been a blessing, this growth has put us in great difficulty regarding our budget to accommodate increased growth and related operating expenses.

Since 2014 I have been coming to Camden diocese for summer ministry, and I have been blessed, graced, and have witnessed the love and generosity of all of you. It's that love, generosity and support that has made a big difference and helped us to reach where we are today! While all of us here are enjoying our beautiful coastal surroundings while vacationing, let us thank God for his blessings by remembering those who count on us for help in improving their living situations. Therefore, I humbly request your valuable and generous contributions towards our mission. Your valuable contribution will go a long way in providing essential health preserving services for the children and families who are in our care, and in building the Kingdom of God through our future priests who are being trained and empowered in our seminary.

I would like to conclude with the words of Saint Mother Teresa of Kolkota, ***“We ourselves feel that what we are doing is just a drop in the ocean. But the ocean would be less because of that missing drop.”***
