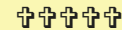

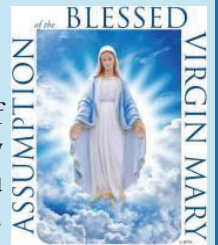

St. John Vianney was born on May 8, 1786 in Dardilly, France. The life of St. John Vianney is a powerful example of true discipleship. He spent many hours a day in the Confessional with the intentions of counseling, saving, and bringing souls back to Christ. St. John Vianney (1786-1859)


Ordained a priest in 1815 and later made the parish priest of Ars, he is commonly known as the "Cure" of Ars". His reputation grew as a confessor and director of souls throughout the Christian world so much that he spent many hours every day in the confessional. He lived a life of torment and mortification which resulted in him having great patience. Saint John Vianney was a true child of God in his simplicity and performed many works of charity and love guiding God's lost sheep back to the fold. He passed away on August 4, 1859 which is his Feast Day.
