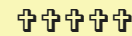

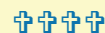

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



This Sunday at the 10:00 AM Mass, our Catechists will be blessed and commissioned to teach the faith to our children who are preparing for the reception of the Sacraments of Penance, Holy Communion, and Confirmation. Our parish is so blessed with many faithful and dedicated Catechists.

They are very busy people, busy with their work as well as their families' duties and obligations. However, God bless them, they are still willing to sacrifice their time and talents to care for the faith formation of the young people.
