Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Gospel today gives us a good moral lesson of why we should live out this moral principle in our lives: "Treat others as you would like to be treated". The story begins: "There was a rich man who dressed in purple garments and fine linen and dined sumptuously each day. Lying at his door was a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man's table."



There is one thing in common between the rich and the poor men: they both died. The rich man was not rich forever and the poor was not poor forever. However, in the life after death, the rich man became "poor" forever and the poor man became "rich" forever. The rich man could be rich in both of his earthly and heavenly "lives" but he missed the God-given opportunity when he was on earth. His destiny was decided by himself and not anyone else.

The rich man's problem is, although the poor man was lying at his door, he did not see him at all. He did not see the poor man because he did not look or pay attention. He did not look or pay attention because he did not need anything from anyone at that moment since he was rich.

However, when in the netherworld "where he was in torment, he raised his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. And he cried out, Father Abraham, have pity on me." At that moment, the rich man was in dire need of help, and because of this, he then raised his eyes looking around, searching around and saw Lazarus whom he did not see before even when he was laying at his door everyday.

Let us look around, search around, to see if any "Lazarus" who are laying at our "doors" or living in our homes or not, and take that opportunity to advance our own salvation before it is gone. Like the rich man, it would be too late! -Fr. Joe Pham
