Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we near the end of this calendar year, we also celebrate Christ the King Sunday, which is the last Sunday of the liturgical year. We adore Jesus Christ Our Lord the King of the universe since he is the creator of the whole universe and redeemer of humanity.

Paston's Desk

Unlike the earthly kings, Jesus Christ is the King of love. The King who came into the world not to live but to die so that his subjects might live. The King who came not to condemn but to redeem. The King who came not to be served but to serve, for this reason, we call him the King above all other kings.

When asked by Pilate "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus replied: "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If my kingdom did belong to this world, my attendants would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not here."

Through baptism, we are redeemed and sealed by Christ the King's blood and so we no longer belong to this earthly kingdom but belong to the Kingdom promised by Jesus Christ. CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of "renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist." The theme of the Revival is: "My Flesh for the life of the World". This three-year effort will have three phases: (1) Diocesan, (2) Parish, and (3) National.

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. "Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal".



A new Safety Ministry is in the works to insure peoples' safety in the event of a crisis, and/or how to recognize such events to address them before they escalate. We are looking for parishioners who are interested in learning more about this new ministry.

We are blessed with some past and present law enforcement agents that attend Mass to be a part of our emergency action plan in the event of a crisis. This ministry is designed to ensure that we are aware of the crisis management recommendations from the diocese, and have parishioners at each Mass trained to be aware of both medical and confrontational situations that may arise.

The Capital expenditures this year were cement work at both churches which were paid with Catholic Strong Reserve Funds.






