Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It is only a few days away that we, together with the whole Church, will joyfully celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God Jesus Christ. In today's Gospel, the focus is on God's salvific plan for St. Joseph, the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus, God's incarnate Son. The New Testament does not give us much information about St. Joseph except his righteousness. As today's Gospel wrote: "Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly." When finding out Mary was pregnant, instead of feeling betrayed and looking for a way to revenge, St Joseph decided not to accuse her before the law which would lead Mary to death by stoning for the "sin of adultery". His virtue of righteousness made St. Joseph not seek revenge but leave "condemnation" into God's hands. Let all men, all husbands and fathers learn from St. Joseph his righteousness by being more loving, caring, tolerating and forgiving. CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of “renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” The theme of the Revival is: “My Flesh for the life of the World”. This three-year effort will have three phases: (1) Diocesan, (2) Parish, and (3) National.

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A - Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B - Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C - Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D - Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E - The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. “Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal”.


