Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



On December 8, together with the whole Church, we will joyfully celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother. God had chosen her from the very beginning to be His first disciple and Mother of His Incarnate Son, Jesus Christ. From the moment of her conception, God sanctified her, freed her from the stain of original sin, so that His Son Jesus Christ would have an immaculate dwelling place in the womb of Mary.

The Immaculate Conception of Mary is not something alienated to human nature; but rather, from the beginning, God created humanity in the state of holiness, free from the stain of sin. Mary was chosen and brought back to that original state of human nature intended by God. God the Father would have never allowed His Son to be born in a womb contracted with any stain of sin. Likewise, God the Son would have never allowed His Mother, the one who bore Him in her womb, to undergo a death which was the consequence of original sin.

The reason for Mary to be chosen as the Mother of God's Son is because she was the best of the best among women. God could not find anyone, except Mary, who was completely submissive to His divine will. When Mary said: "Let it be done to me according to your words", she surrendered her whole being to God's will, she was ready to accept all the consequences entailed.

As children of Mary, we need to learn from Mary, our Mother, her model of faith. We should remind ourselves everyday the "Prayer of Mary, let it be done to me according to your will", the prayer which her Son Jesus also learned and prayed in the garden of agony: "Father, not my will; but your will be done". During Advent, the Season of Hope, let us surrender whatever it is in our lives to God's providential care, and put our whole heart and hope in His will. Remember, God's will is always good for our salvation whether we like it or not.

This ministry is designed to ensure that we are aware of the crisis management recommendations from the diocese, and have parishioners at each Mass trained to be aware of both medical and confrontational situations that may arise. Our first official meeting of the new Safety Ministry will be held on **Monday, December 5th**, in St. Margaret Church at 7:00pm. Any man or woman (over 21 years of age) interested in learning more about (or volunteering for) the new Safety Ministry, please feel free to attend.

CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of “renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” The theme of the Revival is: “My Flesh for the life of the World”. This three-year effort will have three phases: (1) Diocesan, (2) Parish, and (3) National.

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A - Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B - Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C - Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D - Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E - The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. “Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal”.

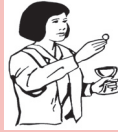


