Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Last week reminded us of the Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade (1973), which legalized abortion in our country. Encountering this Anniversary, the Church in the United States was calling for a Day of Prayer for the protection of unborn children. In responding to this noble call, our parish held a Mass for Life sponsored by our Knights of Columbus. The culture of death seems to be invading our culture today, it has become a “best” solution to all human problems.

However, the reality is that the culture of death is not a solution at all; it is a destruction of life. Life itself is created and given by God, the Creator of all life, the fact is, even with the advances in science and technology in today’s world, human beings still cannot create or even restore a “dead flower” to life. God must have a reason when He creates a new life. He must also have a reason to keep life even, in some circumstances, when some wrongly defined as “no quality of life”. ## **CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL**

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of “renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” The theme of the Revival is: “My Flesh for the life of the World”. This three-year effort will have three phases:

- (1) Diocesan
- (2) Parish
- (3) National

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A - Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B - Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C - Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D - Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E - The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. “Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal”.

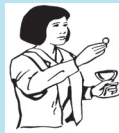


