Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today with the whole Church we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany which is also the Feast Day of our parish. The word Epiphany means manifestation, the Infant Jesus manifested himself to the three gentile Magi, traditionally called Three Kings. These three magi came from the three “corners” of the world. They left their homelands and followed the sign of a bright star which they believed would lead them to a great newborn King.



The scripture does not tell us much about them: their names, their lives, their professions, etc. However, their personal information is not important, it does not have anything to do with human salvation; only the content of the story teaches us about faith and morals. First of all, they used their gifts of God-given intelligence to discern and recognize the divine presence in the sign of nature or the star. Secondly, they must have a strong faith in what they saw in order to set out to an unknown destination. With a strong conviction, they surrendered and entrusted their lives in the sign of the star and kept moving. Thirdly, they also prepared gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to offer the great King as well.

How about us? Do we use our God-given gifts of thinking and reasoning to recognize the signs of nature which reflect various degrees of the existence of God in this created world? A new born baby, sunrise and sunset, these are “miraculous stars”, which we see everyday, and can lead us to Christ Jesus. When we see the “miraculous star” would we be willing to set out to find Jesus in the Eucharist? Remember if the magi did not leave their homes and follow the star, they would never have found the Infant Jesus.

Finally, do we prepare gifts to offer Jesus when we see him after this life? Certainly, Jesus would not like gold, frankincense, or myrrh; rather he would love the gold of our faith, the frankincense of our perseverant prayers, and the myrrh of our sincere conversion. Let us bring with us these gifts to offer the Infant Jesus whenever we come to meet Him at the Eucharistic Table. -Fr. Joe Pham

CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of “renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” The theme of the Revival is: “My Flesh for the life of the World”. This three-year effort will have three phases:

- (1) Diocesan
- (2) Parish
- (3) National

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A - Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B - Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C - Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D - Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E - The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. “Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal”.

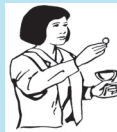


