Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus specifically stated that he came not to abolish the law but rather he came to fulfill it. He said this because the Pharisees and the Scribes accused him of "breaking" the law of Sabbath by healing the sick and the crippled on the Sabbath. Indeed, Jesus did not "break" or abolish the old law but rather he fulfilled it by adding to it one more "law", the law of love.

The Pharisees and Scribes, the scholars of the law, considered themselves righteous since they kept every single letter of the law for the sake of the law while ignoring the spirit of the law. That is the reason why Jesus condemned them: "Unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and of the Scribes, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven".

According to the law: "You shall not kill; and whoever kills will be liable to judgement". However, according to Jesus, one does not have to kill in order to violate this law but rather: "Whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgement" already. The spirit of the law is love, the purpose of the law is to prevent one from violating the law of love rather than to violate the "letter" of the law. To be righteous in the eyes of God is to keep and live the spirit of the law and not the letter of the law.

How often do we keep God's law, the Ten Commandments, and the teachings of His Church just for the sake of the law? "If I don't kill, don't steal, don't commit adultery... I am alright and righteous". Or "since the church's law states that as a Catholic one must go to church on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation, so I don't need to go to daily Mass even if I live next door to the church and have free time". Look at Jesus and see how he treated us from the beginning. He did not treat us according to the "letter" of the law but according the law of love. The letter of law condemned us but the law of love redeemed us. Now Jesus expects us to worship him and to live his teachings with the same spirit, that is, the spirit of the law and not the letter of the law. -Fr. Joe Pham

CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

In 2000, the Bishops of the United States approved plans for a National Eucharistic Revival with the mission of “renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist.” The theme of the Revival is: “My Flesh for the life of the World”. This three-year effort will have three phases:

- (1) Diocesan
- (2) Parish
- (3) National

The Diocesan Phase has already begun on June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The Parish Phase of the Eucharistic Revival will begin on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Our parish will begin a year-long celebration of the Eucharistic Revival with block procession of the Holy Eucharist immediately after the 10:00 am Mass on Corpus Christi Sunday June 11, 2023.

Throughout the year of parish phase, we will continue to plan for activities and events which concentrate on the Holy Eucharist:

- A - Reflecting upon the Eucharist as the Paschal Mystery of Christ (His suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension).
- B - Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharistic species.
- C - Christ is alive and at work in His Mystical Body, the Church.
- D - Full consciousness and active participation in the Eucharistic Liturgy.
- E - The Eucharistic Sacrifice of the Mass is the source and culmination of the whole Christian life.

Let us take advantage of this Eucharistic Revival to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the Mass. Let us make time to participate in all Eucharistic events, lectures, and Eucharistic Adoration so that our intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist would be strengthened. “Anyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal”.




