Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Give me a drink” said Jesus in today’s Gospel. This Gospel is known as “the woman at the well”. In this Gospel, Jesus came up to a Samaritan woman, who “had nothing in common with the Jews” and even looked down on them, asking for a drink. Moreover, this Samaritan woman was a “sinful woman” whom Jesus said: “For you have had five husbands, and the one you have now is not your husband”. The question is why did Jesus approach this Pagan and sinful woman and ask for a drink?



There are only two times in the Bible that Jesus was asking for a drink: “the Gospel of the Woman at the well and at the Crucifixion”. When asking the Samaritan woman for a drink, Jesus did not thirst for water but rather he “thirsted” for her soul, her salvation. Similarly, when dying on the cross, Jesus “thirsted” for the souls of his children, he could not wait to accomplish his mission, the mission to die for the salvation of mankind.

Again, Jesus’ “thirst” will not be satisfied until all generations are subjected to his will and be saved. Everyday Jesus is knocking on our consciences asking for a “drink”. Everyday he is whispering in our hearts: “I thirst”. He thirsts for our love, he thirsts for the conversion of sinners, he thirsts for our kindness and generosity toward others, he thirsts for our compassion toward the unfortunates and the brokenness. He thirsts for our mercy and forgiveness of those who have wronged us.

Let us offer Jesus a “drink”, the drink that would satisfy his “thirst”, the “drink” that cost him his life on the cross. During this Lenten Season, let everyone of us offer Jesus a “drink” of gratitude, a “drink” of loving worship, a “drink” of charitable work, a “drink” of loving and forgiving spirit, a “drink” of true conversion of heart and soul. Let us offer Jesus our body, mind, and soul so that, in return, he would give us his “drink” which would satisfy our “thirst” for all eternity. -Fr. Joe Pham

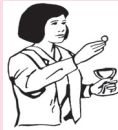




