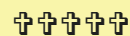

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



On Monday March 20th, the whole church will celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the foster father of Jesus. Traditionally, this Feast was celebrated since the end of the 10th century and declared “Patron Saint of the Universal Church” in 1870 by Blessed Pope Pius IX. Later, Pope Pius XII proposed him as the “Patron of Workers”.

We don't have much information about St. Joseph in the Biblical text. However, according to the Scripture, St. Joseph was chosen by God, just like the Blessed Virgin Mary, to cooperate with God in His salvific plan for humanity. He was chosen to be the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus Christ. He was known for his righteousness because he did not want to expose Mary to shame and to the law which would have led her to be stoned to death due to “adultery”.

Like Mary, St. Joseph was totally obedient to God's will for him by receiving Mary and her child, Jesus, into his care. He raised and nurtured Jesus through his hard labor as a carpenter. For this reason, He is truly deserved to be called Patron Saint of the Universal Church who would defend and protect the Church in time of difficulty as he protected Jesus when King Herod tried to kill the Infant Jesus. He would seek out the lost sheep and bring it back to the Church as he searched for the “lost Jesus” in the temple.

Husbands and fathers should look up to St. Joseph for guidance and learn from His righteousness and faithfulness. Husbands and fathers should cooperate with God's will to nurture and care for the “domestic churches” entrusted to them. They are called to be providers, protectors, and teachers of the faith in their families. They are called to be righteous in words and deeds and to be faithful in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. 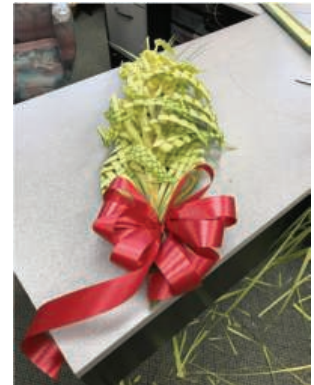


