Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today, with the whole Church, we joyfully celebrate the “heritage” of our religion. This heritage is not an object; it is a Person whom we are united to in His Body and Blood. At the Last Supper, Jesus left us His precious Body and Blood as “nourishment” for our souls, a sign of His presence on earth, a loving communion between God and man, and a pledge of salvation for all.

Every year we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. We are reminded that Jesus does not abandon us but he stays with us until the end of time in the form of the Holy Eucharist. Jesus constantly invites us to come to His Eucharistic Table in order to be intimately united to Him, to be part of His sacrifice which is the same sacrifice of His Body offered on Calvary for the salvation of mankind two thousand years ago.

As baptized in the new life of Jesus Christ, confirmed and strengthened by the Holy Spirit, we need to be nurtured by the Bread of Life which is the source of strength for our earthly pilgrimage and the pledge of our eternal life. However, this Bread of Life cannot be found anywhere except in the celebration of the Eucharist. For this reason, we, as believers, should attend Mass on Sundays and be in union with Jesus through the reception of His precious Body and Blood. We can pray to God at any time and anywhere; however we cannot receive salvation or be redeemed unless we participate in the sacrifice of the Holy Mass in which Jesus’s Blood is being poured out for the forgiveness of our sins.

The sacrifice is there, the source of salvation is there, the grace of forgiveness is there, and ultimately the Redeemer is there; however, if we are not there, the salvific sacrifice of Jesus Christ cannot be automatically imposed upon us. It is our choice whether we want to be saved or not.

Remember the words of Jesus: “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood will have life eternal” (John 6:51). When Jesus said this He meant it. -Fr. Joe Pham

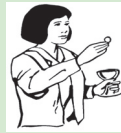


