Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today we celebrate the mystery of the Blessed Holy Trinity, the essence of our faith. Through Jesus' revelation, we are able to know about the nature of the Blessed Trinity: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (Matt 28:19).

There are three distinct Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; but only One God and all are equal in power. Why three Persons but only One God, this is still a profound mystery is impossible for our human mind to grasp or understand. How can we, as creatures, understand our creator? Or how can man-made things understand human nature? If we can understand God then God is not God at all because God would be inferior to us and not a Supreme Being.
