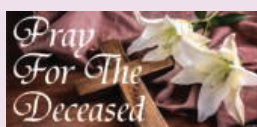

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



What a caring and consoling words in Today's Gospel: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest" (Matt 11:28). First of all, we should give thanks to God for giving us the faith through our Baptism. Through faith we are able to come to know God, to love God, and to live God in our lives. Secondly, this gift of faith is freely given to us through Jesus Christ: "All things have been handed over to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him" (Matt 11: 27).

To be human is to be subjected to "labor and burdens" regardless of theist or atheist. Therefore, thanks to Jesus Christ for giving us the faith that we would know whom we should turn to for help when the "labor is so heavy and the burden is so unbearable". Let us bring to Jesus our burdens whatever they are: moral burdens, mental burdens or physical burdens which we have to face everyday of our lives. Let us come to Jesus with our moral burden, the burden of our sins and the sins of others. Let us come to Jesus with our mental burden, the burden of broken relationships between husband and wife, parents and children, brothers and sisters, relatives or friends, the burden of seeing our loved ones suffer physically, or mentally. Also, let us come to Jesus with our physical burden, the burden of illness, disability, or hard labor.
