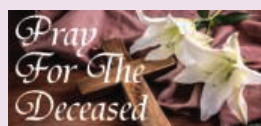

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Tuesday August 15<sup>th</sup>, the whole Church will joyfully celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mary's body and soul assumed into heaven. The Assumption of Mary is an affirmation of eternal life which Jesus Christ has promised us as Mary's offspring. We are no longer Eve's children; we are Mary's children now. The gates of heaven were unlocked for all of us when Mary responded "yes" to God by accepting Jesus into her womb. 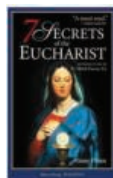

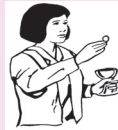
