BISHOP'S DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES

In August 2022, Bishop Sullivan issued and published the "Decree Regarding Parish Mass Schedules" in the Diocese of Camden in the Star Herald. The reason for this Decree is that much sooner than later, **most of the parishes will be served by only one priest.** Therefore, the requirement of a reduction in the parish Mass schedule is unavoidable.

According to the Bishop's Decree, **the parish with two priests should have only three Masses on Sunday.** Therefore, after taking into consideration the Mass attendance, financial and pastoral aspects, the Parish Council and I have decided the **4:00 PM Mass on Sunday at St. Margaret church must be discontinued, effective January 1st 2024.**

It is heartbreaking for me to make this announcement. None of us wanted to reduce Masses=however we have to face the reality of our time, the changes of Mass attendance, and ultimately the shortage of priests in our diocese.

For the next few years, there will be scarcely one priest for one parish or sadly even we may have to combine or merge parishes again in responding to the declining number of priests. Please keep praying for the priestly vocations in our diocese so that this painful and heartbreaking decision will not have to be made in the future.

May God bless us with more priestly vocations.

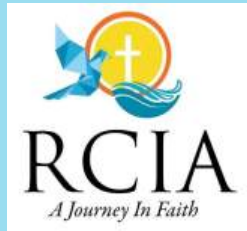


