Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



“Who do people say that the Son of Man is?” asked Jesus in today’s Gospel. When Jesus asked his disciples this question, they replied: “Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah, or one of the prophets”. Surprisingly, Jesus did not seem to be interested or care so much about what others said about him; but rather he emphasized: “But who do you say that I am?” Then Peter quickly responded: “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God”. The disciples had followed Jesus for years. They had heard Jesus’s teaching with their own ears. They had seen Jesus performing miraculous deeds with their own eyes. They had eaten at the same table with Jesus; therefore Jesus wanted to know what and how much they truly knew about him.

Today Jesus would ask each one of us the same question: “Who do you say that I am?” Like St. Peter’s answer, Jesus expects a personal response from our hearts. Do we know Jesus only through learning from Catholic school or Religious Education and so knowing him as an “informational” Jesus? Or do we know Jesus only by going to church, receiving the Sacraments and so knowing him as a “religious” Jesus? If we only know the “informational” Jesus or “religious” Jesus, we are “building” our faith-foundation on “sands”. However, Jesus has done so much for us personally. Everyday he is involved in every “part” of our being since without him there is nothing coming into existence, without him nothing is good. Therefore, we should know him not through information or religious practice only but also through his active divine intervention in our lives.

If we take time to discern and reflect, we would recognize Jesus’ loving care in our relationships with our loved ones. We would recognize him in the “daily bread” at our dinner tables. We would recognize his protective care in everything that is going on in our lives and our families. Only knowing Jesus in this way, our “house or faith” would not be ruined or collapsed when “storm, wind, or flood” comes. *-Fr. Joe Pham*

BISHOP’S DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES

In August 2022, Bishop Sullivan issued and published the “Decree Regarding Parish Mass Schedules in the Diocese of Camden” in the Star Herald. The reason for this Decree is that much sooner than later, **most of the parishes will be served by only one priest.** Therefore, the requirement of a reduction in the parish Mass schedule is unavoidable.

According to the Bishop’s Decree, **the parish with two priests should have only three Masses on Sunday.** Therefore, after taking into consideration the Mass attendance, financial and pastoral aspects, the Parish Council and I have decided the **4:00 PM Mass on Sunday at St. Margaret church must be discontinued, effective January 1st 2024.**

It is heartbreaking for me to make this announcement. None of us wanted to reduce Masses; however we have to face the reality of our time, the changes of Mass attendance, and ultimately the shortage of priests in our diocese.

For the next few years, there will be scarcely one priest for one parish or sadly even we may have to combine or merge parishes again in responding to the declining number of priests. Please keep praying for the priestly vocations in our diocese so that this painful and heartbreaking decision will not have to be made in the future.

May God bless us with more priestly vocations.

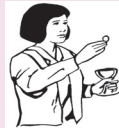


