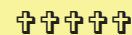

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday at St. John Vianney Church, we will celebrate the Feast of St. John Vianney, one of the patron Saints of our parish. St. John Vianney was born on May 8, 1786 in Dardilly, France. The life of St. John Vianney is a powerful witness to God's unconditional love and infinite mercy. He spent hours a day in the confessional to counsel the lost, to forgive sinners and bring them back to the truth which ultimately would save their souls. His personal holiness, his zeal for conversion of sinners, and his love for the broken moved the hearts of many whom eventually came back to the Church.



Today more than ever, Jesus needs more "John Vianneys" who have enough patience to listen to the lost, the broken, the troubled, and the outcasts. A John Vianney who would understand rather than complain, a John Vianney who would be able to co-suffer with the suffering, a John Vianney who would reach out to sinners not to condemn but to redeem, a John Vianney who would be able to forgive the unforgivable and to love the unlovable. 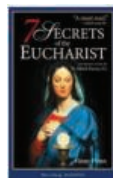




