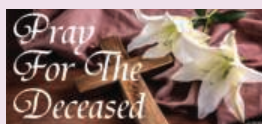

This Sunday our Catechists will be blessed and commissioned to teach the faith to our children who are preparing for the reception of the Sacraments of Penance, Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

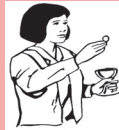


