Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus gave another parable regarding the kingdom of heaven: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock.... Again around noon....around three....about five.....but each of them also got the usual wage....What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?" The moral teachings of this parable are: First, it is never too late to receive salvation, secondly envy is a sin directly against God, and thirdly God's mercy is infinite.

For God, it is never too late to receive salvation. God is always waiting for sinners to turn away from sin and be saved rather than quickly condemn them. It is only too late to be saved when sinners refuse to turn away from sin and accept God's invitation to salvation. Remember, even at the last hour of the day, the landowner still invited someone to work in his vineyard and get a full payment.

The second moral teaching is that envy is a sin that directly sins against God since every good thing comes from God. Whenever we are envious of others about some good things they have and we don't have, we are truly and directly sinning against God. Whatever others have is given by God and God is surely free to do as he wishes.

The third moral teaching is that the mercy of God is infinite. Indeed, God's mercy has no limits or boundaries, no one would say that: "God has run out of mercy for me". God mercifully reaches out to sinners even at the last minute on a death bed. His arms are always open and patiently waiting to embrace sinners at any minute for their return. The only thing is whether sinners are going to give themselves a chance to be saved or not. *-Fr. Joe Pham*

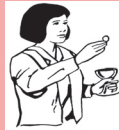
