Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Gospel, Jesus was asked by the Pharisees whether they should pay the census tax to Caesar or not? Jesus responded: "Whose image is this and whose inscription?" They replied: "Caesar's". Then Jesus said to them: "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God".

By saying that, Jesus was referring to Caesar as "earthly things". The things that we labor all day and night for such as shelter, food, clothes, careers, social status, fame, wealth, etc. These things occupy all our time and drain all our energy to the point that we feel so assaulted at the end of the day. The problem is that we often "over repay" what belongs to "Caesar", and fail to "repay" what is due to God. Remember, we are created by God and made in His image and likeness; thus our whole person "body and soul" belongs to God. Meanwhile, our souls have been also imprinted with an indelible mark, the (inscription), of the Blessed Trinity since our baptism: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

There are so many ways and so many opportunities for each of us to repay what belongs to God. Our parish is so blessed with various ministries: Knights of Columbus, Women's Club, Senior Citizen Club, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Comforting Ministry, Grief Support Ministry, Parish Nursing Ministry, Kings Men, Lector and Eucharistic Ministry, Usher and Altar Server Ministries, Legion of Mary, Altar & Rosary Society, Choir & Music Ministries. 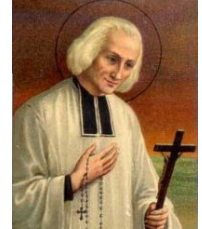

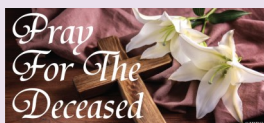

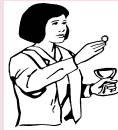
