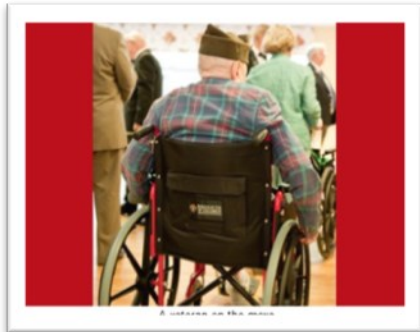
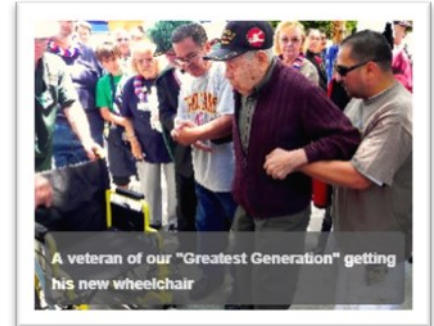


Wheelchair Weekend Appeal

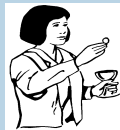


