Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we come to the end of the year and also the end of the Liturgical Year, the Church designates this last liturgical Sunday as Christ the King Sunday.

Throughout the liturgical calendar, the Church celebrates the mystery of redemption and the history of human salvation beginning from the Birth of Christ, His Paschal Mystery (Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection), and finally the Triumphant Kingship of Christ.

This Sunday we honor and recognize the Kingship of Christ as the King of the universe, the King of heaven and earth, the King of kings, Lord of lords, and ultimately the King of love. Unlike other earthly kings, our King, Jesus Christ, rules not by imposing fear upon His subjects or dominating them by His authority and power; but rather by love, compassion, and mercy. Unlike other kings, Christ our King came to serve and not to be served. He came to redeem and not to condemn. Unlike other kings their subjects died for them, Christ our King sacrificed and died for his subjects.

This is the kind of King we are honoring and worshiping. We submit our whole being to Him. We want Him to rule over us, and we long to live in his Kingdom, the Kingdom of love, the Kingdom of peace, the Kingdom of eternal life and happiness. Let us bring Christ the King into our lives and the lives of our loved ones by coming to worship Him on Sundays, by bringing and encouraging our loved ones to attend the banquet of the King prepared on the Altar for all. Let us beg the King of love: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom". (Luke 23:42).
