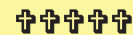

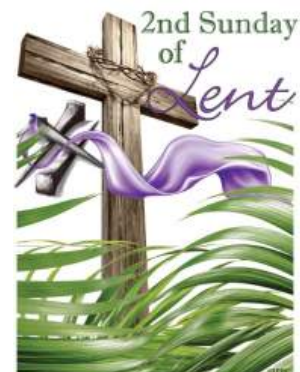
LENTEN REGULATIONS

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we continue our Lenten journey with Our Lord Jesus Christ into the second week of Lent, the Gospel of St. Mark gives us a glimpse of what we are longing to see at the end of our earthly life: the beatific vision. Indeed, the Transfiguration of Jesus Christ is giving us a sense of what heaven is like.



Before dying on the cross, Jesus wanted his three disciples, Peter, John, and James, to experience how delightful it was to be in the presence of God in heaven. Witnessing the Transfiguration of Jesus Christ, Peter, John, and James were speechless by the esthetic of the heavenly light and the delightfulness of the mind and soul. The three disciples did not want to leave there. At that moment, they wanted to cling to the spark of heaven. There was nothing else in this world that would distract or attract them from that heavenly blessedness.

However, in order to be with the Transfigured Jesus, they had to go “down” the mountain to accomplish the mission entrusted to them by Jesus on the hill of Calvary. If we want to be with Jesus in heaven, we need to make our journey to Calvary as well. Let us follow Jesus’ footsteps to Calvary by carrying with us all our troubles, problems, wariness, sorrows, hurts, pain, suffering, addictions, and even sinfulness and nail them on the Holy Cross of Christ. Let the deepest longing of heaven in our hearts be a source of strength and determination for our journey. Let the heavenly light of the Transfiguration clear all stumbling blocks: selfishness, indifference, pride, lust, greed, hatred, etc., which prevent or discourage us on the journey to our heavenly homeland. Whatever we try to do in this earthly life, remember the words of St. Peter when he saw just a glimpse of heaven:

This year, the Diocese of Camden is hosting its 11th Annual **FaithFULL Food Drive** during the Lenten Season.

In the months after Thanksgiving, Christmas, and the New Year, food pantry shelves are thinly stocked, while the need remains high. In South Jersey, 1 in 6 people are food insecure. Counting just children, that number jumps to 1 in 5. While so many ministries are collecting food year-round, think of the impact we can have when we all work together! **FaithFULL Food Drive** is a unique service because we do it together across 6 counties and 62 parishes. It is enriching for our diocesan community to partake and reflect on this service as a team during the holy season of Lent, and in the wake of the pandemic as many face additional challenges, it is particularly important.

The most needed items for those experiencing food insecurity are: Canned Beans, Dried Pasta and Rice, Canned Spaghetti Sauce, Cooking Oils and Vinegars, Canned Fruit and Fruit Cups, Nutritious Snacks (Nuts, Granola Bars), Dried Mashed Potato and Stuffing Mixes, Canned and Hearty Soups, Peanut Butter and Jelly.

The food collected by Infant Jesus Parish will be used by our St. Vincent de Paul Society to fill the Easter baskets.

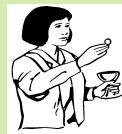

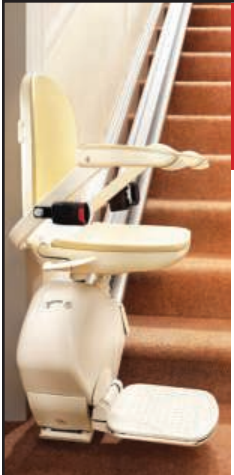
