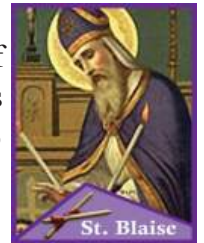

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the Second Reading today, St. Paul tells us that he felt so compelled to preach the Gospel to all with any cost: “I have made myself a slave to all so as to win over as many as possible. To the weak I became weak, to win over the weak. I have become all things to all, to save at least some. All this I do for the sake of the gospel, so that I too may have a share in it.”

Also, in today’s Gospel, Jesus felt the need of spreading the Word of God to all people as well: “Simon and those who were with him pursued him and on finding him said, ‘Everyone is looking for you.’ He told them, ‘Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come.’ So he went into their synagogues, preaching and driving out demons throughout the whole of Galilee.”

If Jesus said: “For this purpose have I come”, we too have no exception. The purpose of our life is to know God, to love God, and to live God in our lives and also to spread this Good News to whomever we encounter in this life. However, bringing God’s Word to others cannot be done through preaching or talking about God only, because in this way, no one would come to believe it. Rather we must do like St. Paul did and do the same like Jesus did.

As St. Paul “became a slave to all, became weak with the weak, and became all things to all.” Let us become slave of loving service to our loved ones and others before we preach or talk about Jesus to them. Let us become weak by putting ourselves in the same situations of those who live their lives in faithlessness or in the darkness of addictions before we talk about “turn away from sins and believe in the Gospel”.

Also, like Jesus who healed the people along his preaching of the Word of God, we too must do the same. Of course, we cannot heal people physically, but we can heal them and comfort them spiritually. A word of caring, a word of forgiving, or an act of love and kindness, these can heal people and bring them comfort and consolation. - *Fr. Joe Pham*

**Abstinence** - All persons who are 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on **Ash Wednesday, on all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.**

**Fasting** - All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**, while the other two meals are to be light.

## Blessed Mother Statue

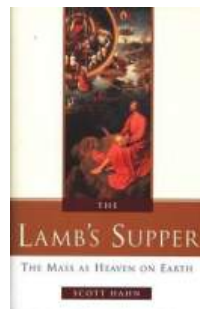
Infant Jesus Parish parishioners are invited to schedule a visit to your home from our beautiful statue of Our Blessed Mother.

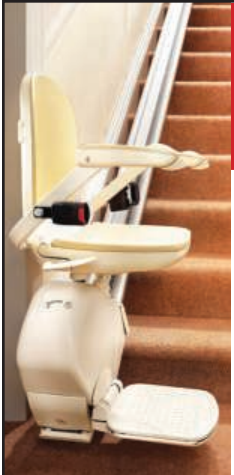
