Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



On Tuesday March 19th, the whole church will celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This Feast was honored since the end of the 10th century and was declared Patron Saint of the Universal Church in 1870 by Pope Pius IX. We don't have much information about St. Joseph in the Biblical text.

However, according to Scripture, St. Joseph was chosen by God, just like the Blessed Virgin Mary, to cooperate with God in His salvific plan for humanity. He was chosen to be the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus Christ. He was known for his righteousness because he did not want to expose Mary to shame and to the law which would have led her to be stoned to death due to "adultery". Like Mary, St. Joseph was totally obedient to God's will for him by receiving Mary and her child, Jesus, into his care. He raised and nurtured Jesus through his hard labor as a carpenter. For this reason, He truly deserves to be called Patron Saint of the Universal Church who would defend and protect the Church in time of difficulty as he protected Jesus when King Herod tried to kill the Infant Jesus. He would seek out the lost sheep and bring them back to the Church as he searched for the "lost Jesus" in the temple.

Husbands and fathers should look up to St. Joseph for guidance and learn from His righteousness and faithfulness. Husbands and fathers should cooperate with God's will to nurture and care for the "domestic churches" entrusted to them. They are called to be providers, protectors, and teachers of the faith in their families. They are called to be righteous in words and deeds and to be faithful in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. May St. Joseph's righteousness inspire all of us to live righteously in all aspects of our lives.

This year, the Diocese of Camden is hosting its 11th Annual **FaithFULL Food Drive** during the Lenten Season.

In the months after Thanksgiving, Christmas, and the New Year, food pantry shelves are thinly stocked, while the need remains high. In South Jersey, 1 in 6 people are food insecure. Counting just children, that number jumps to 1 in 5. While so many ministries are collecting food year-round, think of the impact we can have when we all work together! **FaithFULL Food Drive** is a unique service because we do it together across 6 counties and 62 parishes. It is enriching for our diocesan community to partake and reflect on this service as a team during the holy season of Lent, and in the wake of the pandemic as many face additional challenges, it is particularly important.

The most needed items for those experiencing food insecurity are: Canned Beans, Dried Pasta and Rice, Canned Spaghetti Sauce, Cooking Oils and Vinegars, Canned Fruit and Fruit Cups, Nutritious Snacks (Nuts, Granola Bars), Dried Mashed Potato and Stuffing Mixes, Canned and Hearty Soups, Peanut Butter and Jelly.

The food collected by Infant Jesus Parish will be used by our St. Vincent de Paul Society to fill the Easter baskets.

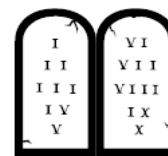
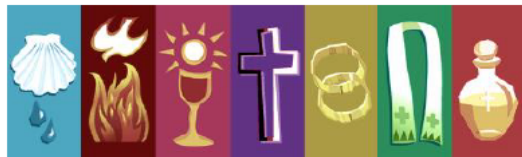

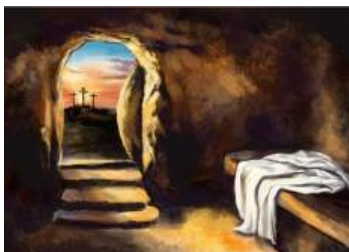
