Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Throughout the New Testament, we will not find any passage which describes Jesus as an angry person except in today's Gospel. Jesus was angered because the people disgraced the Temple of the Lord. They used the place of worship, a holy site, for their temporal gain, for their "worldly business" instead of "God's business". Indeed, nothing would trigger Jesus' anger except misusing, disgracing, or disrespecting the "Temple" of God.



Today, conceivably we would not dare to do anything that would disrespect or disgrace the "Temple of God" when we are in Church. However, the "Temple" of God is not confined merely to the physical building; but rather every person is a living "Temple" of God. We are all the living Temples of the Lord, a place where God is dwelling, living, communicating, and acting every day. Therefore, if anyone who disgraces, hurt, or destroys this living "Temple" of God by any means, words or deeds, certainly it would trigger Jesus' anger and ultimately be wiped out of the heavenly Temple.

During this time of Lent, every one of us should be reminded that this living "Temple" is so precious in the eyes of God, it is so loved to the point that God, Jesus, had to sacrifice His own life to redeem it. Therefore, this is the time for us to pass judgement on our own "temples" and not others. This is the time for us to "clean up" our own "temples' trash": malice, hatred, resentment, envy, unfaithfulness, greed, etc. This is the time for us to heal and to build up the "temples" of the Lord instead of abusing or destroying. This is the time to "fix" the "temples" of the Lord, not by using "bricks and stones"; but by using the means of mercy, compassion, reconciliation, forgiveness, healing and loving support.

Let us not evoke Jesus's anger again.

This year, the Diocese of Camden is hosting its 11th Annual **FaithFULL Food Drive** during the Lenten Season.

In the months after Thanksgiving, Christmas, and the New Year, food pantry shelves are thinly stocked, while the need remains high. In South Jersey, 1 in 6 people are food insecure. Counting just children, that number jumps to 1 in 5. While so many ministries are collecting food year-round, think of the impact we can have when we all work together! **FaithFULL Food Drive** is a unique service because we do it together across 6 counties and 62 parishes. It is enriching for our diocesan community to partake and reflect on this service as a team during the holy season of Lent, and in the wake of the pandemic as many face additional challenges, it is particularly important.

The most needed items for those experiencing food insecurity are: Canned Beans, Dried Pasta and Rice, Canned Spaghetti Sauce, Cooking Oils and Vinegars, Canned Fruit and Fruit Cups, Nutritious Snacks (Nuts, Granola Bars), Dried Mashed Potato and Stuffing Mixes, Canned and Hearty Soups, Peanut Butter and Jelly.

The food collected by Infant Jesus Parish will be used by our St. Vincent de Paul Society to fill the Easter baskets.
