Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



After the resurrection, the Risen Christ had appeared to his disciples several times in order to affirm them of his resurrection. In today's Gospel, Jesus appeared to the disciples again and even invited them to touch his hands and feet to clear out the doubt in their minds: "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost doesn't have flesh and bones as you see I have."

Our Lord Jesus is indeed living and acting in our lives. Every one of us can testify to this since we have experienced Jesus's presence and his healing touch in times of illness and hopelessness. His comfort in times of sorrow and suffering. His peace in times of trouble and fear, and his strength in times of despair and uncertainty.

The disciples' faith in the resurrection of Christ is based on the "empty tomb" and the several appearances of the Risen Christ. As you may be aware, due to health issues, Deacon Frank Dunleavy has been unable to perform his ministerial duties. Unfortunately, his health issues still remain; therefore he petitioned Bishop Dennis Sullivan to relieve him from his parish assignment at Infant Jesus Parish. On March 27, 2024, Bishop Sullivan accepted Deacon Frank's petition for Permanent Medical Leave.

Besides faithfully fulfilling the duties and responsibilities as a husband, father, and grandfather, Deacon Frank had also taken upon himself the sacred duty to serve as a Deacon at our parish for nine years. The word "deacon" means "servant"; indeed, Deacon Frank faithfully lived out the very meaning of his Deaconate ministry. He has been using his God-given gifts and charism to bring the faithful closer to God through his words, deeds, and his inspired homilies. For nine years of his Deaconate pastoral ministry, he unquestionably has touched and changed so many lives through his administration of the Sacraments and the Liturgical celebrations. Through Baptism, he has planted the seed of faith in many new lives. He has celebrated weddings and conducted funeral services in which he was there to rejoice with those who rejoiced and to weep with those who wept. Deacon Frank has also brought Holy Communion, the Body of Jesus Christ, to the sick in the hospitals, the homebound, the elderly, and spent hours listening and comforting them.

We are so grateful and appreciative for his selfless service and his dedication to the parish. His zeal, his gentleness, his dedication, compassion, and his sacrificial heart are greatly appreciated and will not be forgotten. As per Deacon Frank's request, there will be no receptive farewell. Currently, Deacon Frank and his family have settled in South Carolina.

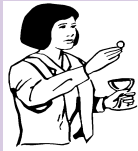
