On March 27, 2024, Bishop Sullivan accepted Deacon Frank's petition for Permanent Medical Leave.

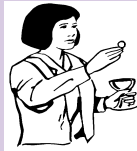

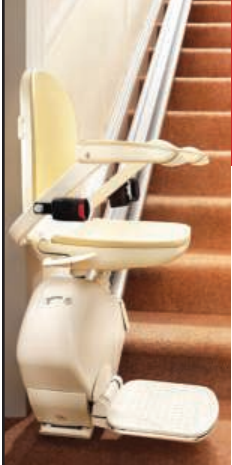
