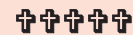

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In today's Second Reading, St. John says: "Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth." True love must be involved in action since the first principle required for true love is the act of sharing. One should not say: "I love you" unless he/she must be willing to "share something" with the beloved. Love without sharing is "love of oneself" and that should not be called "love" at all. We learn this from Jesus Christ our Savior who shared His own life for love of us. Moreover, sharing also requires sacrificing, one can not share anything unless one is ready to sacrifice. Therefore, true love entails sharing and sharing leads to sacrificing. This is the kind of love we have received from our loving God.

We use the word "love" everyday but how often do we put it into the action of sharing and sacrificing? If we want to know how much we love someone, there is only one way to measure it, that is, based on the "amount" of sharing: The more sharing, the greater the love. The reason why Jesus' love is the greatest one, is because he has shared totally: He shared his divine life with us which belonged to God alone and ultimately his own life on the cross for us.

During this Easter Season, we are called to love God through His people which means sharing our God-given blessings with our needy brothers and sisters, sacrificing these earthly means for the sake of His Body, the Church. 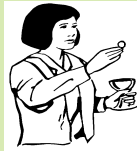

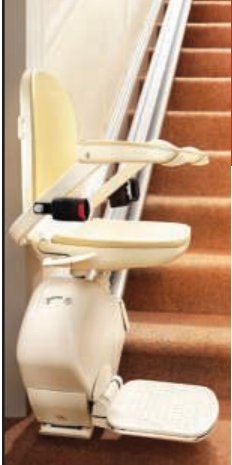
