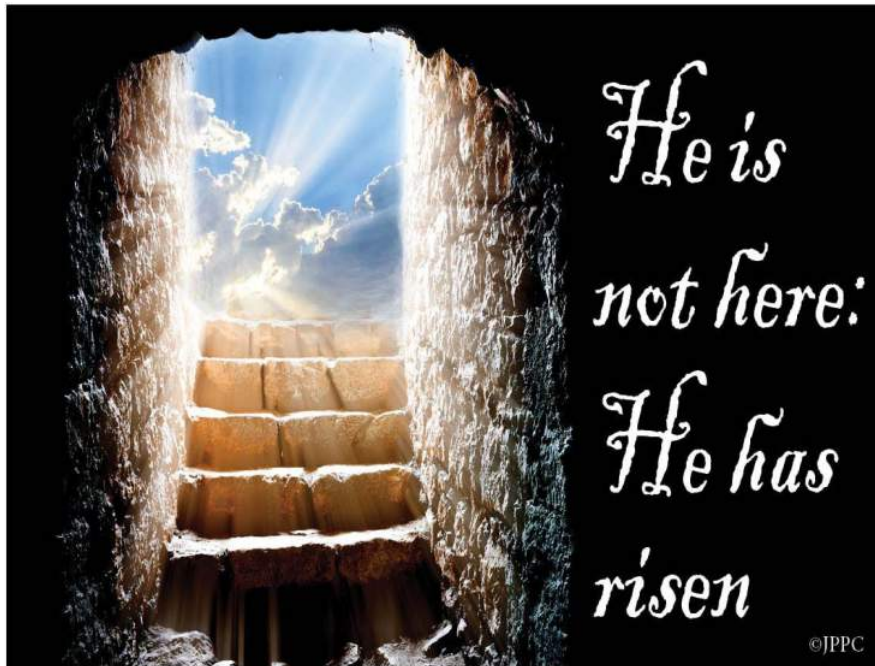

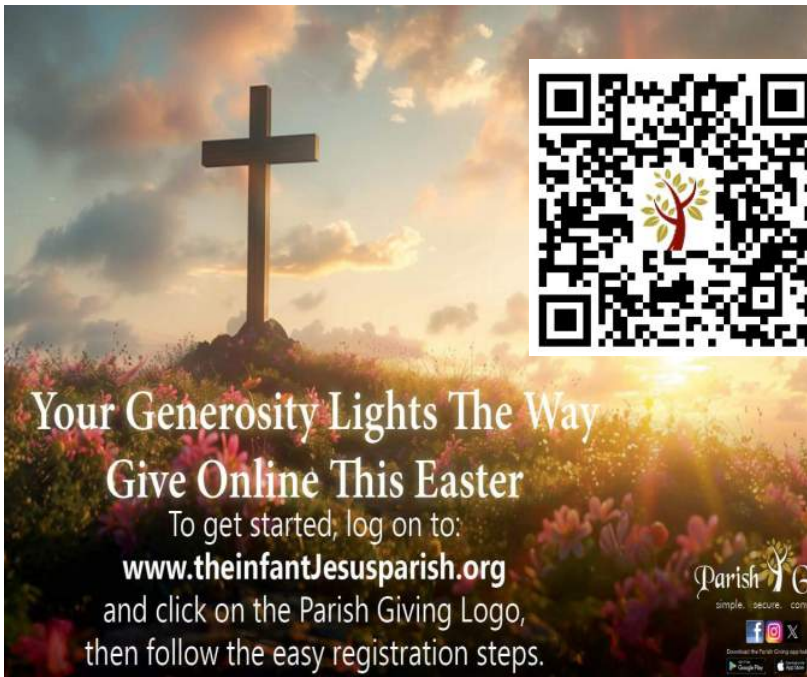

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Alleluia! Praise the Lord! Christ is risen! Death is defeated, we are redeemed, and the gate of eternal life is opened for all who believe in the Risen Christ. The Resurrection of Christ is the answer for a longing in our hearts, the longing to live and to be happy forever.



We are the Easter people and Alleluia is our song. Our faith in the resurrection of Christ is not based on the so called “myth”; but rather it is based on a solid foundation, the blood testimonies of Jesus’ disciples. According to Scripture, St. Peter denied Jesus three times and the rest of Jesus’ disciples abandoned Him when he was arrested and crucified. They all denied and betrayed Jesus.

However, His disciples’ faith strengthened when they witnessed the resurrection of Christ for themselves. Their faith in the Risen Christ, whom they denied and abandoned, now grew ever stronger. It grew to the point that they were willing to sacrifice their own lives for their love and their faith in the Risen Christ. Imagine if Jesus’ disciples did not truly encounter the Risen Christ. 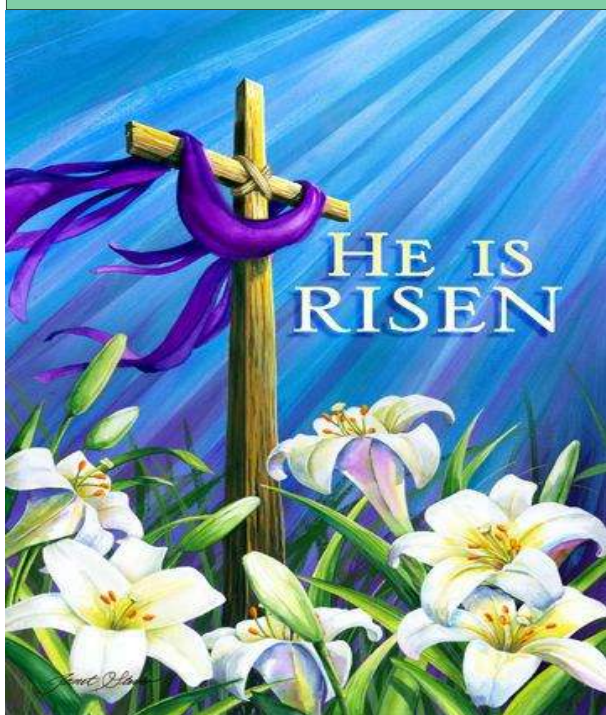
