Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today, with the whole Church, we joyfully celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles after the Ascension of Jesus Christ. The celebration of Pentecost Sunday also marks the end of the Easter Season.



The word “Pentecost” is derived from the Greek word meaning fifty days, fifty days from Easter Sunday. Pentecost is often misunderstood as the “Birthday of the Church”. Theologically, it is not at Pentecost that the Church was born; but rather the Church was born from the wounded side of Jesus on the cross. Just like the old Eve was born from the side of the old Adam, the New Eve, the Church, was born from the side of the New Adam, Jesus Christ, who was nailed on the cross. Pentecost marked the beginning of the manifestation of the Church to the whole world. The descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles gave them the gifts needed to boldly proclaim the Good News of the Gospel of Christ and to manifest the Bride of Christ, the Church, to the whole world.

The first gift given by the Holy Spirit to the Apostles was the gift of speaking different languages, which made everyone with different races and tongues able to understand them. The messages they spoke were so powerful that, on that day alone, thousands of people became believers. It was by the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit that the Apostles were so courageously preaching the truths revealed by Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit spoke in and through the Apostles so powerfully and effectively it touched the hearts of thousands of people who changed their hearts and became believers.

Today the Holy Spirit is still working in every one of us if we are willing to open ourselves to the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit would empower us not to be afraid to speak the truths and live the truths in our lives. Let us all pray to the Holy Spirit: “Come, Holy Spirit and renew the face of the earth”. *Fr. 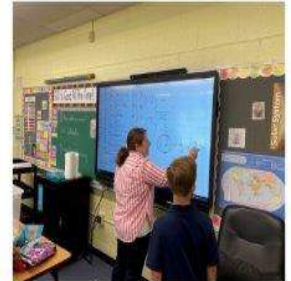
