Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today we celebrate the mystery of the Blessed Holy Trinity, the essence of our faith. Through Jesus' revelation, we are able to know the nature of the Blessed Trinity: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (Matt 28:19). There are three distinct Persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; but only One God and all are equal in power.

Why three Persons but only One God? This is still a profound mystery that our human mind is impossible to grasp or understand. How can we, as creatures, understand our creator? Or how can man-made things understand our human nature? If we can understand God, then God is not God at all because God would be inferior to us and not a Supreme Being.

However, it does not mean that because the Blessed Trinity is a mystery we do not know anything about the Trinity at all. Thanks to Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity who revealed to us through the scripture that love is the "key" that "makes" the Three Divine Persons One God: "Whoever does not love does not know God, for God is love." (1John 4:8). This Trinitarian love is being shared with humanity and reflected vividly in each family. Every family is a result of love and a reflection of the image of the Blessed Trinity. Love unites, sustains, and nurtures members of the family.

Today our culture also sets aside a day to celebrate Father's Day. We honor and pray for all deceased and living fathers for their essential role in the family. 


