





Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As members of the Church, we joyfully come to celebrate our Church's Divine Inheritance, Corpus Christi, the Blessed Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Our Lord Jesus loved us and cared for us so much that he established this Sacrament at the Last Supper as "food" for our souls and a living sign of his presence in the Church, his Mystical Body.

At the Last Supper, Jesus took the bread and wine saying: "This is my body... this is my blood..." he truly meant it. Therefore, undoubtedly what we receive every Sunday from the Altar is truly Christ's real Body broken and real Blood poured out for the forgiveness of our sins. For this reason, we need to attend Sunday Mass in order to be saved. Salvation is there on the Altar for everyone; however, we must come and receive it. Indeed, we do not deserve to receive Christ's Body and Blood at all if Christ does not allow us.

Therefore, attending Mass is truly a blessing and a privilege rather than a "law to keep" or a "waste of time". Mass is not like attending a ceremony or watching a performance on the stage. Rather it is an active participation, in the Paschal Mystery of Christ: his suffering, death, and resurrection. When one says, "I don't have time for Mass or I don't need to go to Mass" it means that "I don't have time for salvation, or I don't need salvation".

This is not a matter of having time or not. It is not a matter of need or no need. This is a matter of life and death for all eternity. Do not let Satan, the deceiver, deceive us. Do not let anyone fool us or persuade us. Do not let worldly things pull us away from the Eucharistic Table. Since, at the end of our lives, no one can help us. We can take nothing with us. Only the One who conquered death, the One who gave His own Body and Blood as a pledge of eternal life can raise us up and take us to his eternal Kingdom. Amen!






