In today's Gospel, Jesus sent seventy-two followers ahead of him in pairs to every town and village he intended to visit. Their mission was to "cure the sick in it and say to them, the Kingdom of God is at hand for you."


This mission is also entrusted to each one of us at our Baptism and we are constantly reminded at the sending forth at the end of each Mass: "Go in peace and glorify the Lord by your life".

Today more than ever, the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few". Jesus truly needs our feet to go out to the "field" to be Christ-like to others, he needs our hands to reach out to those in need of our "bread", our understanding, patience, our loving care or our forgiveness to heal the hurt and the broken. Jesus needs laborers who are willing to bring comfort and consolation to the grieving and hope to the hopeless. Remember the words of Jesus: "The harvest is abundant" meaning the needy, the despair, the sorrow, and the suffering are "abundant" around us but "the laborers are few".




