



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


The story of Martha and Mary in today's Gospel is a "wake-up call" for all of us. It reminds us of the purpose of our lives and what we should do to achieve that purpose. Martha invited Jesus into her home and was "burdened with much serving"; whereas Mary, her sister, was sitting and listening to Jesus' teaching. When Martha could not take the "burden of serving" anymore, she asked Jesus to tell her sister, Mary, to help her serve. However, instead of telling Mary to help her sister, Jesus responded: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, and it will not be taken from her."

We are human beings and not "human-doing". We should concern ourselves more with being with God through our prayers rather than spending all time "doing". Everyday our "living" must be rooted in the love of God and of the truth of his teaching. Everyday our "doing" must be rooted in prayer and motivated by the love of God. In other words, we must try to balance between our spiritual life and earthly life. When entering Martha's house, Jesus wanted her to benefit from his preaching rather than having a good "meal" from her. He wanted her to be more concerned with the heavenly things over earthly things. He wanted her to know that whatever she was doing on earth must be geared to only one thing: eternal life.

Moreover, Martha's problem was that she forgot who she was preparing this meal for, who she was serving. She was just "doing" for the sake of "doing" and not being conscious of the fact that she was "doing" out of the love for Jesus. If she was aware of who she was serving, she would not feel so "burdened"; but rather she would feel more delighted and satisfied by serving the one she loved.

How often do we feel "burdened" by taking care of our loved ones? If we "do" it merely for the sake of "doing" then it would certainly become a burden. However, if we "do" it out of love, then it would be a joy and not a burden.
