


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus said to his disciples: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing! There is a baptism with which I must be baptized, and how great is my anguish until it is accomplished!"

When sin entered into the world, humanity was separated from the loving union with God and was destined to eternal damnation. This was not God's intention when He created humanity. He created us with free will to choose life and not death and a heart to love and not to "lust". By disobeying God's will, human beings chose "eternal death" over eternal life and turned the love of God into "lust of evil".

In order to redeem humanity and to bring humanity back to the love of God, God had to send his Only Son into the world who could not "wait" to ignite a "blaze". The fire of his love in human hearts by his bloody baptism on the cross. Our Lord, Jesus, was so anguished to accomplish this mission of love so that all generations would know how much God has loved them. In the meantime, "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division". Division means separating "love" from "lust", right from wrong, good from evil, and light from darkness.

O my children, has my sacrificial love on the cross set a fire in your hearts? Are your hardened hearts melting by my infinite love and mercy for sinners? Don't waste our lives any longer. 



## OUR LADY OF FATIMA LOVES TO VISIT




