


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel reminds us that: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life."

As we celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross of Jesus Christ, we are reminded of how God has loved us. In responding to his love, we should follow Jesus' footsteps which means walking on a "narrow road" on which not many would like to travel. We do not like to hear about suffering and death. We do not like to hear about illness and aging, sorrow and pain, betrayal and hurt, rejection and destruction, etc. Unfortunately, whether we like them or not, they are the "crosses" which we have carried and experienced in our daily lives.

As faithful followers of Christ, we do not like "crosses", we do not like suffering, but we accept it, just as Jesus accepted his passion in the Garden and offered it to God the Father as a sacrifice for our salvation. We should not try to save our earthly lives by turning away from God, by placing the blame on God for the crosses in our lives, by causing and imposing crosses on others, or by making others' crosses heavier. Instead, we should "lose our lives for the sake of Christ and the Gospel" by joining our crosses to Jesus' cross and offering these crosses to God the Father as sacrifices for our own sins and the sins of others. We can use all the means and blessings given to us by God to alleviate, lessen, or soften the crosses of our loved ones and those around us. In this way, we are truly living our faith, making our faith alive and shine. We must live faith and not just have faith: "What good is it? So also, faith of itself if it does not have works, is dead," said St. James. *- Fr. Joe Pham*


