




Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Saturday November 1st, the whole Church will celebrate the Feast of All Saints. Historically, this Feast originated in Rome. There was a pagan temple in Rome called the Pantheon. This temple was dedicated to the service and veneration of all the pagan deities. After the downfall of paganism, the Christians took possession of the temple. Later in 607, Pope Boniface, dedicated this temple to the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the Saints. In due time, the Pope deposited a number of relics of the martyrs in this church, and eventually, the Feast of all Saints emerged and was celebrated annually.

Liturgically, the Church chooses November 1st to commemorate the Feast of all Saints. The Saints are the glory of the Church because they are the evidence of her sanctity. The Church has always honored them in a special manner. Their names, their lives, their relics have been the objects of veneration. Throughout the history of the Church, Christians everywhere have invoked the Saints, trusted in them, and believed that their prayers would merit an abundance of graces.

The Saints are the heroes whose deeds are worthy, not only of praise, but also of imitation. Recently Pope Francis canonized St. Mother Teresa as a Saint of our time. Her whole life was centered on God's love and compassion for humanity. She drew her strength from the fountain of God's loving grace which empowered her to do what she did for the poor, the abandoned, the sick, the orphaned and the broken. Her whole life was about co-passion or suffer-with the suffering. She was able to see what we often don't see: the suffering Jesus in others.

Let each one of us pray to St. Mother Teresa to help us to see what she saw, to love what she loved, and to do what she did so that someday our names will be written in the Book of the Saints in heaven. - Fr. Joe Pham

The Infant Jesus Parish finance council reports the financial situation of our Parish for this past fiscal year.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the rectory and one of the finance council members will be in touch.

(1) The Capital expenditures for the 2025-2026 fiscal year are budgeted for \$100,000. The projects performed to date are a new parking lot at St. Margaret Church utilizing the Catholic Strong funds and a new AC unit at St. John Vianney utilizing our Revolving Fund Savings Account. Also included in capital expenses will be replacement of the St. John Vianney Rectory/Father Szolack Center's HVAC Unit. This will be funded using our Revolving Fund Savings Account.

(2) The Capital expenditures for the 2024-2025 fiscal year were Roof Repairs at Infant Jesus Parish Rectory and Concrete Step Repairs at the Rectory Office. The total is \$19,217.00. The funds used are from our Revolving Fund Savings account as such, are not included with the operating budget.


