
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

November is *National Family Caregivers Month*. Caregiving is an essential role in a growing number of families today. Caregivers may find it difficult to find time for themselves, manage emotional and physical stress and/or balance caregiving with other areas of their life. Practicing good self-care is not selfish.



- Perform additional duties as assigned by the Pastor and Business Administrator


