



Dear Brothers and Sisters-

This coming Wednesday is the celebration of Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lenten Season. Although Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of obligation; it is a “Holy Day of Restoration.” The ashes remind us of who we are. We are mortal, we are sinners, we are dust and unto dust we shall return.



When we receive the ashes, the minister makes the sign of the cross on our foreheads and proclaims "Repent and believe in the Gospel". Repenting and believing in the Gospel is the only way to transform our mortality into immortality. It is the only way to change our “nothingness” into “preciousness” and it is the only way to change our eternal damnation into eternal beatific vision of God in heaven.

Ash Wednesday helps us to be in touch with our sinfulness and weaknesses so that we would have in our hearts a longing to be a better priest, religious, husband, wife, mother, father, son, daughter, brother, sister, and neighbor. Ash Wednesday invites us to follow Jesus who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, who delivers us from the slavery of sin, addiction, hopelessness, misery, suffering, and eternal death. Ash Wednesday empowers us to journey faithfully to Calvary,- the “hill of death” for Him; but it is the “hill of life” for us all.

Let us take time to worship Jesus on Ash Wednesday. Let us come to ask Jesus to rescue us from our spiritual death, and let us come to ask Jesus, “remember me when you come into your kingdom”. Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation; it is indeed a Holy Day of Restoration from Death to Life.




WHAT IS LENT?

The 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by prayer, fasting, abstinence, and other acts of penance.
