








Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



We are entering the Holy Season of Lent, the Season in which Jesus invites each one of us to unite our physical, emotional, and spiritual burdens/crosses with His on the Cross as sacrificial offerings to God the Father for our own sins and the sins of others.

Today's Gospel recounts the temptation of Jesus Christ which also reminds us of our own battles with Satan in our daily lives. The word "Satan" means deceiver or liar. Indeed, Satan tried to deceive Jesus by tempting Him not to go to the path that leads to the Cross on Calvary. Satan cleverly tempted Jesus by whispering into Jesus' "ears" all forms of delusion and deception of power. The deceiver tempted Jesus to use his divine power to change the sinfulness of human hearts instead of using his sacrificial love which was the way of the Cross. However, Jesus was determined to use his sacrificial love on the Cross to gain our hearts. He wanted us to change our sinful way of living not by fear of Him but by loving Him. He wanted the submission of our hearts and souls, and there was only one way to do this, the way of Calvary.

With the same temptation, Satan tempts us daily by appealing to all our wrong desires which are against God's will. He does this by urging us to dominate the weak, to oppress the lowly, and to take advantage of the vulnerable. Satan wants us to be indifferent to the broken and suffering, and to be insensitive to the needs of others. This is all against God's will.

Let us embrace these forty days of Lent as a journey of "turn around" and as a spiritual renewal by being in touch with God through our prayers, almsgiving, and acts of charity so that Satan, the deceiver, will not have a chance to deceive us from the truth taught by our Lord Jesus Christ.


